Beta Theta Pi believes in the cultivation of the intellect. Historically, Betas have been leaders at their universities in several areas, including academics. It is important for a chapter to develop its members so they are accomplished and well-rounded, ensuring that they are placing the best men into the work force and graduate schools. Success in the classroom will help brothers become leaders on their campuses and eventually their communities.

The mission of this document is to assist the chapter and its members in promoting the Men of Principle Initiative's devotion to the cultivation of the intellect. Central Michigan University and the Interfraternal Council recognize our academic standing on a semester basis. Therefore we also will recognize and assess each brother's academic success based on his semester GPA's.

Academic Rating Scale:

Exceptional

- Semester GPA of 3.5 or greater

Good

- Semester GPA of 3.0 to 3.49

Probationary I

- Semester GPA of 2.5 to 2.99

Probationary II

- Semester GPA of 2.0 to 2.49

Suspension

- Semester GPA below 2.0

A semester GPA below 2.0 for two consecutive semesters will result in your membership in Beta Theta Pi being brought to the chapter for renewal.

We understand that there may be a "bad" semester from time to time. This may cause little change to one's cumulative GPA but it would be unwise to overlook such a drop in semester GPA, even if that person's academic status does not dip into probationary I or II standing. This is why each brother will also be rated on a sliding semester scale.

One's semester GPA cannot decrease by more than 0.49 from their cumulative GPA without sanction assigned by the _Kai_ Committee.

(for example, if brother X has a 3.52 cumulative GPA, and gets a 3.02 this fall, he is not under probationary status, but is subject to sanctions given by the _Kai_ Committee)

Upper Classman: 3.0+

Transfer: 3.0+

*** Weekly Study Hrs determined as a class

Sanctions for Probationary Statuses may include any or all of the following, as decided by the _Kai_ Committee:

1. Study Hours
2. Additional community service
3. Removal of voting rights
4. Social Probation
5. IM Sports probation
6. Extra Sober days
7. Other sanctions available at the discretion of the Kai Committee
