The Re-Founding Father education meetings will take place on a weekly basis, synonymous with a fraternity's chapter meeting. Each meeting will explore a different goal of the *Men of Principle* Initiative, complete with group discussions lead by various undergraduate officers and chapter advisors. The meetings typically last two and one half hours.
