EG INITIATION - APRIL 23, 2005

Epsilon Gamma welcomed four new members on Saturday, April 23, 2005, during an initiation ceremony held at the Hall of the Chapters in Oxford, Ohio. Just three months and one day after the colony's first initiation ceremony, five Epsilon Gamma undergraduates filled the primary roles, while brothers from the Alpha chapter rounded out the ceremony. District Chief A.J. Calkins, GMI-EMI (now Kettering) '88, and EGHC President Thomas C. Olver '98 were on hand for the festivities. The Chapter is pleased to announce the following new initiates:

In a special moment at the conclusion of the ceremony, colony members called Education Consultant Vito U. Brandle, Saint Louis '04, forward to sign the official role of the Epsilon Gamma chapter as No. 334. Brandle played a key role in last fall's expansion effort and has made countless trips to Mt. Pleasant over the past seven months, assisting with the colony's education and development. He will continue his work with the chapter over the next year.

Prior to the Initiation, colony members enjoyed a tour of the Administrative Office and Beta Campanile, courtesy of Zac Haines, Miami '05, who also took the lead in organizing the ceremony. After the ceremony, the men (joined by Brandle, Calkins and Olver) participated in an educational planning session for fall recruitment with the help of incoming Director of Expansion and Recruitment J.B. Scherpelz, Miami '05. Colony President Chris Olson '06, who will serve as the colony's delegate to the 166th General Convention in Scottsdale, Ariz., this August, is eager to double the colony's size this fall. Matt Bush '08, Kris Wellman '07 and Ben Reedy '08 will attend The Institute for Men of Principle in Oxford this summer, and all nine undergraduate members will reside in the house for the 2005-06 school year.
