CMU's Homecoming this year is on October 16th. Game time is 12 noon.

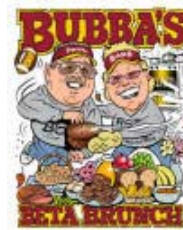
Barb and Bubba are back again providing a delicious brunch for all of us Betas and our guests at 814 S. Main just prior to the game.
